- 7 TECHNOLOGY AND INNOVATION.** Exploring new and emerging technologies and innovative context sensitive approaches to the treatment of local streets to improve the management of traffic.
- 8 CATERING FOR ALL ROAD USERS.** Planning and designing for all road users including public transport, trucks, cyclists, pedestrians, etc.
- 9 GROUP WORKSHOP EXERCISE.** Working through a real life case study to decide where action is warranted, develop a strategy, and come up with a scheme solution.
